64th Annual Sale of Registered Beulah Speckled Faced Ewes

A similar entry of ewes as numbers of Speckle ewes offered each year become slightly less. A good crowd of purchasers with trade good throughout, by all means not a flying trade but the choice pens trading above £220.

The sharp mule breeding sorts remain in strongest demand although the money certainly wasn't flying around. A top price of £288 for the first pen of yearlings of £288 for the first prize pen of yearlings from Messrs RG & BM Jones & Son, Ty-Mawr. Second prize from Messrs T A Swancott & Son, The Lawn topping at £230, with a further eight lots £200 plus.

Messrs B I Price & Son to £230, RG & BM Jones & Son to £220 (twice), MJ & JM Price, Pencrug to £202, likewise M E Thomas & Sons, Caerau.

Commercial yearlings from £145 - £175, these looked good value and certainly Vendors would be slightly disappointed at some prices achieved, with only smaller types £105 - £130

A very small show of older ewes these topping at £195 for the second prize pen from DG & G Davies & Son, Llwynpiod, first prize three's from MJ & JM Price, Pencrug to £192.

The stronger older ewes trading from £150-£175 with smaller sorts from £110-£135.

A very good clearance with averages very similar to the year.
